ACT Branch – Election of Two Federal Council Delegates - Acceptance of Nominations.

I have received nominations for the current (Stage-2) elections in your organisation and have accepted those of ACT Branch Council Members whose names are included in the attachment.

A ballot will be necessary for the offices of “Two Federal Council Delegates” (representing the ACT Branch).

The voters for the ballot consist of the five ASMOF, ACT Branch Council Members who were recently declared elected to office on 30 March 2009.

I will conduct a draw in my office at 10.00am on Thursday, 23 April 2009 to determine the order in which candidates' names will appear on the ballot paper. Candidates and their representatives are invited to attend.

The ballot will open on 4 May 2009 and close at 10:00am on Monday, 18 May 2009. In accordance with Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, declaration envelopes in the form prescribed by the Act must be used in all postal ballots. Voters will receive with their ballot paper, a declaration envelope which must be signed by the voter for the vote to be admitted to the count.

The scrutiny of ballot papers will be held in my office immediately after the ballot close.

Candidates may appoint scrutineers to represent them during the course of the election. Any such appointment must be advised to me in writing. Scrutineers should contact me if they wish to be present at any stage of the ballot including the scrutiny. Scrutineers must produce a letter of authority or suitable identification on their initial introduction to me or my staff. Absence of a scrutineer will not delay any step in the election.

The roll of voters (i.e. consisting of the five ASMOF, ACT Branch Council Members) is available to ACT Branch Council Members for inspection and copying at my office during ordinary business hours. Any ACT Branch Council Member wishing to inspect or copy the roll of voters should make an appointment with me.
