Important Information

Financial Obligations of Membership: Members shall pay entry fees, fees, levies and subscriptions in accordance with ASMOF Rule 9, Rule 12, Rule 13, Rule 14, Rule 15 and Rule 23, and shall pay fines in accordance with Rule 23 and Rule 67.

The membership subscription payable is set out in the attached fee schedule.

Associates are not liable for the payment of any fees.

Resignation from Membership: A member may resign from membership of the ASMOF by written notice addressed to and delivered to the Secretary of the Branch to which the member has been assigned.

Notice of resignation from membership of the ASMOF takes effect:

- (i) where the member ceases to be eligible to become a member of the ASMOF;
 - (a) on the day on which the notice is received by the ASMOF; or
 - (b) on the day specified in the notice, which is a day not earlier than the day when the member ceases to be eligible to become a member;whichever is later, or
- (ii) in any other case:
 - (a) at the end of two weeks after the notice is received by the ASMOF, or
 - (b) on the day specified in the notice;whichever is later.

Termination of membership by resignation does not affect the liability of the member or former member to pay such entry fees, fees, levies or subscriptions as may have been owing at the date of resignation, and such moneys may, subject to the Rules of the ASMOF, be sued for and recovered in the name of the ASMOF.

Any subscription paid by a member in respect of a period beyond the date when the member's notice of resignation takes effect shall be remitted to the member if so requested and a member who pays the annual subscription by instalments shall not be liable to pay any instalment for any period after the members notice of resignation takes effect.

NOTE: When applications are processed, if an applicant for membership is recorded as being a member of the ASMOF from a date earlier than the date of this application, that earlier date will be treated as the date of application and this will be confirmed to the applicant in writing.

ASMOF Disclaimer

The Council of ASMOF (NSW) reserves the right to decline assistance or provide assistance on a conditional or other basis. In particular, the Council may exercise its discretion in cases where a member requests assistance in relation to an issue which was known to the member prior to joining ASMOF (NSW).

Disputes between members: ASMOF will strongly recommend that disputes between members should be dealt with by way of mediation. ASMOF will not assist a member in a dispute with another salaried medical practitioner where the member has been an ASMOF member for less than 12 months (except at the discretion of the Council).
